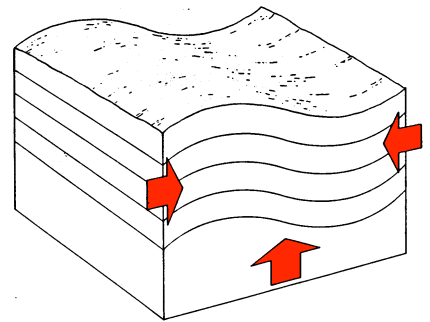


Formation of an Unconformity- an unconformity is a "missing layer of rock" or a gap in the record. Simply put, it is a "buried erosional surface."

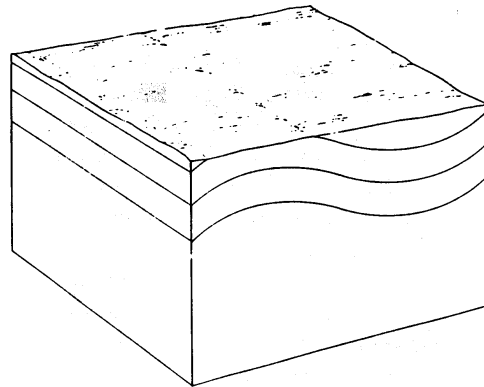
- Layers are formed according to superposition.



- Something happens to uplift the area- (folding, faulting, etc).



- Erosion wears away the uppermost layers



- Area submerges and deposition begins again.
